Please observe and follow the rules listed:

- 1. Camping at these sites are for youth charter groups/organizations. Youth groups are defined as 18 years and younger.
- 2. Reservations are accepted for these sites starting the first working day of January for that year. They may be made by phone, in person or e-mail request. When making the reservation, please have the following information ready: name of group/organization, number in group, number in group (adults and children), dates you would like to camp and the contact person's name, address and phone number.
- 3. A non-refundable reservation fee must be paid within ten (10) working days of making the reservation to secure your site. The cost is \$20.00 for Residents and \$40.00 for Non-Residents. This fee is applied to your overnight stay upon check-in.
- 4. The balance of the camping fee must be paid prior to arrival or upon arrival at the Park Office during its business hours. The fee is \$3.00/person per night. Cash, check, money order or Visa/MasterCard are acceptable forms of payment. Please note that rates are subject to change. There are no refunds for overpayment.
- 5. When full payment is made, the lock combination will be provided to gain access to the Youth Primitive Campground. Contact the Park Office (during business hours) 24-48 hours prior to arrival date.
- 6. Check out is at 11:00 am.
- 7. All four (4) sites have a maximum occupancy of 30 people.
- 8. Each site is equipped with a fire ring and a picnic table. The bathhouse in the Family Campground **IS NOT** available to Youth Primitive Campers. Non-potable water and portable toilet units are provided on site; electric is not.
- 9. Vehicles are not allowed at the primitive camping site. Vehicles may unload at the site, and then park in the designated area.

10.PLEASE USE CARE NOT TO DAMAGE TREES!

- a. Clotheslines may be used with care during daylight hours, but are prohibited after dark.
- b. Chopping, cutting or damaging live trees and bushes in any way is forbidden.
- c. Collecting any fallen wood is prohibited.
- d. Firewood and ice may be purchased at the Campground Office.
- 11. Reasonable guiet must be maintained at all times. QUIET HOURS are from 10 pm to 7 am.

- 12. The Carry In, Carry Out Trash Policy applies. Do not burn trash in the fire rings.
- 13. Please notify the Park Office in writing, of any planned special events at least thirty (30) days in advance (i.e., Camporees, Scenarios, etc.).
- 14. Please follow all Division and Park Rules and Regulations.
