1. Groups can consist of Boy Scouts; Girl Scouts; Church Youth Programs; Non-Profit Youth Organizations; Family Reunions or Large Groups. Any fees paid are non-refundable.
2. Tent camping only
3. **Strictly Prohibited:** Swimming; Alcohol; Pets; RV's &/or other camping units
4. Groups check-in at the Campground Park Office upon arrival. Please provide a list of names in the group in event of an emergency.
5. Youth/Groups must be supervised by an adult at all times.
6. Visiting hours are from 8 am through Sunset. All visitors are required to pay Park Entrance Fees. Visitors are not included in the reservation &/or camping fees.
7. The Park Closes at Sunset. Groups must stay at their camping area from Sunset to Sunrise.
8. Trash: Trap Pond State Park is a "Carry In/ Carry Out" park. Litter in the camping areas will not be tolerated
9. **Boy Scout Area** is a primitive camping area for 15 – 50 people. A maximum of 3 vehicles allowed with additional parking in the Main Lot. Groups must carry in their own water. Only Port-a-Johns are available. Entrance to the primitive camping area is through the Main Parking Lot.
****The trail through the picnic area can only be used for after hour's emergencies.****
10. **Cypress Point** is for primitive camping area for 25-100 people. The camping area is located to left of the Restrooms. Pavilions cannot be used unless the group has a paid reservation for them. A water faucet for drinking water is available.
11. Fires must be confined to the fire rings; cannot be left unattended at anytime
12. Driving nails into trees &/or any damage done to trees will not be tolerated.
13. Groups will be held responsible for any damage done to park property and facilities.
