## Trail Description

### Sea Hawk Trail

This flat trail meanders through a mixed hardwood and conifer forest before ending in a grassy meadow near the Indian River shoreline. Birding and wildlife viewing opportunities exist for nature enthusiasts as they experience the different coastal bay environments along the trail.

### Seahorse Trail

The Seahorse Trail provides access to the western portion of the park. The trail travels over packed earth along forest edge, open meadow, and dense forest.
